The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 469929.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the information marked as "552.108" in report numbers 09-16071 and 09-13220 may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold the information marked as "552.108." To the extent the information responsive to the request regarding the 2008 and 2011 incidents exist, we assume you have released it. *See* Gov't Code §§ 552.301, .302.
