The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 602110 (McKinney Ref. 15-018012).

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the submitted information must be withheld from the requestor. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 58.007 of the Family Code, you must withhold Exhibit B-1. Additionally, in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold Exhibit B-2. However, you must release the basic information from Exhibit B-2 pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.
