Dear Ms. Silver:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 623407.

The City of Dallas (the "city") received a request for a list of pet licenses and intact animal permits, including specified categories of information, during a specified time period.¹ You claim the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.101 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted representative sample of information.²

Section 552.101 of the Government Code excepts from disclosure "information considered to be confidential by law, either constitutional, statutory, or by judicial decision." Gov't

¹We note, and you acknowledge, the city did not comply with the requirements of section 552.301(e) of the Government Code in providing some of the information at issue. *See* Gov't Code § 552.301(e). Nonetheless, because section 552.101 of the Government Code can provide a compelling reason to overcome the presumption of openness, we will consider its applicability to the submitted information. *See id.* §§ 552.007, .302, .352.

²We assume the "representative sample" of records submitted to this office is truly representative of the requested records as a whole. *See* Open Records Decision Nos. 499 (1988), 497 (1988). This open records letter does not reach, and therefore does not authorize the withholding of, any other requested records to the extent those records contain substantially different types of information than that submitted to this office.

Code § 552.101. Section 552.101 encompasses section 826.0311 of the Health and Safety Code, which provides:

(a) Information that is contained in a municipal or county registry of dogs and cats under Section 826.031 that identifies or tends to identify the owner or an address, telephone number, or other personally identifying information of the owner of the registered dog or cat is confidential and not subject to disclosure under [the Act].

(b) The information may be disclosed only to a governmental entity or a person that, under a contract with a governmental entity, provides animal control services or animal registration services for the governmental entity for purposes related to the protection of public health and safety. A governmental entity or person that receives the information must maintain the confidentiality of the information, may not disclose the information under [the Act], and may not use the information for a purpose that does not directly relate to the protection of public health and safety.

Health & Safety Code § 826.0311(a), (b). You state Exhibit B is maintained by the city as part of its pet registry. You assert release of this information would identify or tend to identify the owner of a registered dog or an address, telephone number, or other personally identifying information of the owner of a registered dog. Based on your representations and our review, we find the information we have indicated in Exhibit B identifies or tends to identify the owner or an address, telephone number, or other personally identifying information of the owner of a registered dog and is subject to section 826.0311. We have no indication the exception in section 826.0311(b) applies. Accordingly, the city must withhold the information we have indicated in Exhibit B under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 826.0311 of the Health and Safety Code.

You state Exhibit C consists of a report maintained in the city's Chameleon database, which contains the city's pet registry and other information. However, you do not state, and we are not able to determine, whether Exhibit C was obtained directly from the city's pet registry. Accordingly, we must rule conditionally. It does not appear the exception found in section 826.0311(b) of the Health and Safety Code applies in this instance. Thus, to the extent the information we have indicated in Exhibit C was obtained directly from the city's pet registry, the city must withhold the indicated information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 826.0311(a) of the Health and Safety Code. However, to the extent the information we have indicated in Exhibit C was not obtained directly from the city's pet registry, the information is not confidential under section 826.0311(a) of the Health and Safety Code and the city may not withhold it under section 552.101 of the Government Code on that basis. Further, we find you have failed to establish any of the remaining information identifies or tends to identify the owner of a registered dog or cat or consists of an address, telephone number, or other personally

identifying information of the owner of a registered dog or cat for purposes of section 826.0311(a). Therefore, the city may not withhold any of the remaining information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 826.0311 of the Health and Safety Code. As you raise no further exceptions to disclosure, the city must release the remaining information.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.
