Dear Ms. Lentz:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 642036.


The Williamson County Sheriff's Office (the "sheriff's office") received a request for information pertaining to a specified incident. You claim portions of the submitted information are excepted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.130 of the Government Code provides information relating to a motor vehicle operator's or driver's license or permit, a motor vehicle title or registration, or a personal identification document issued by an agency of Texas or another state or country is excepted from public release. Gov't Code § 552.130(a). You state the sheriff's office lacks the technological capability to redact the motor vehicle information contained in the submitted video recordings. Accordingly, we find the sheriff's office must withhold the submitted video recordings in their entireties under section 552.130. *See* Open Records Decision No. 364 (1983). Furthermore, the remaining information contains motor vehicle record information. Thus, the sheriff's office must also withhold the motor vehicle record information you marked under section 552.130 of the Government Code. As you raise no further exceptions to disclosure, the sheriff's office must release the remaining information.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
