
You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 636567.

The Legislative Budget Board (the "board") received a request for the most recent quality assurance team documents for the Comptroller's Office, the Texas Department of Transportation (the "department"), and the Texas Workforce Commission (the "commission"). Although you take no position as to whether the submitted information is excepted under the Act, you state release of this information may implicate the interests of the Comptroller's Office, the department, and the commission. Accordingly, you inform us you notified these interested third parties of the request for information and their right to submit comments to this office. *See* Gov't Code § 552.304 (interested party may submit comments stating why information should or should not be released). We have received comments from the Comptroller's Office stating it has no objection to the release of its information. As of the date of this letter, we have not received comments from any of the remaining interested third parties explaining why the requested information should not be released. We have reviewed the submitted information. As no objections to release of this information have been raised, it must be released to the requestor.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
