Dear Ms. Anderson-Nelson:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 638489 (ORR# W001113-092716).

Dallas Area Rapid Transit ("DART") received a request for the file pertaining to a specified right of way. You state DART released some information. Although you make no arguments as to whether the submitted information is excepted under the Act, you state release of this information may implicate the interests of the City of Dallas (the "city").¹ Accordingly, you state, and provide documentation showing, you notified the city of the request for information and of its right to submit arguments to this office as to why the information at issue should not be released. *See* Gov't Code § 552.304 (interested third party may submit comments stating why information should or should not be released). We have considered comments submitted by the requestor. *See id.*


As of the date of this letter, we have not received any comments from the city explaining why any portion of the submitted information should not be released to the requestor. As no exceptions to disclosure have been raised, the submitted information must be released.

¹Although you raise sections 552.101 through 552.156 of the Government Code, you have not provided any arguments explaining how these exceptions are applicable to the submitted information. Therefore, we will not address the applicability of these exceptions. *See* Gov't Code §§ 552.301(e)(1)(A), .302.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
