The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 650706.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the submitted information must be withheld from the requestor. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 261.201 of the Family Code, you must withhold report number 04-147276 pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code. Furthermore, in accordance with section 552.108(a)(2) you may withhold the remaining submitted report. However, you must release the basic information from the remaining submitted report pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.
