Dear Ms. Moody:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 646370.


The McKinney Police Department (the "department") received a request for information related to a specified incident. The department released information responsive to the request but made redactions as permitted by section 552.130 of the Government Code without requesting a decision from this office. *See* Gov't Code § 552.130(c). Pursuant to section 552.130(d), the requestor has asked this office to review the information and render a decision as to whether it is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130. *Id.* § 552.130(d). We have considered the department's position and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.130 of the Government Code excepts from disclosure information relating to a motor vehicle operator's driver's license and motor vehicle title or registration issued by an agency of this state or another state or country. *Id.* § 552.130(a)(1), (2). We understand the requestor asserts she has a right of access to some of the submitted motor vehicle record information the department previously withheld from her. *See id.* § 552.023(b); Open Records Decision No. 481 at 4 (1987). However, upon review, we have no indication the requestor has a right of access to any of the information subject to section 552.130. Accordingly, the department must withhold the information we have marked under section 552.130 of the Government Code.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
