
Dear Mr. Beauchamp:

The Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (the "commission") received a request for F-5 reports pertaining to named peace officers and asked whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"). Your request was assigned ID# 646721. In response, this office issued Open Records Letter No. 2017-03911 (2017) on February 22, 2017. We have examined this ruling and determined that an error was made in its issuance. When this office determines that an error was made in the decision process under sections 552.301 and 552.306 of the Government Code, and that error resulted in an incorrect decision, we will correct the previously issued ruling. Consequently, this letter serves as a substitute for the decision issued on February 22, 2017. *See generally* Gov't Code § 552.011 (providing that Office of Attorney General may issue decision to maintain uniformity in application, operation, and interpretation of the Act).

We note the request at issue was ruled on in Open Records Letter No. 2017-03873 (2017). Accordingly, the commission must follow Open Records Letter No. 2017-03873 when determining the proper disposition for the requested information. This office will consider
