Dear Ms. Aguilar:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 648356 (City ID# KMan1A).

The City of Corpus Christi (the "city") received a request for information related to a specified incident involving a motor vehicle. The city released information responsive to the request but made redactions as permitted by section 552.130 of the Government Code without requesting a decision from this office.¹ *See* Gov't Code § 552.130(c). Pursuant to section 552.130(d), the requestor has asked this office to review the information and render a decision as to whether it is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130(a) of the Government Code. *See id.* § 552.130(d). We have considered the city's position and reviewed the information.


¹The city also redacted public citizens' dates of birth in accordance with a previous determination issued to the city in Open Records Letter No. 2016-00831 (2016), which authorizes the city to redact that type of information without a ruling from this office. The city also redacted a telephone number pursuant to Open Records Letter No. 2011-16393 (2011), a previous determination authorizing the city to withhold, under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 772.318 of the Health and Safety Code, the origination telephone number of a 9-1-1 caller furnished to the city by a 9-1-1 service supplier established in accordance with chapter 772 of the Health and Safety Code.

Section 552.130 of the Government Code excepts from disclosure information relating to a motor vehicle title or registration issued by an agency of this state or another state or country. *Id.* § 552.130(a)(2). Accordingly, the city must withhold the information you have marked under section 552.130 of the Government Code.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
