Re: Request for a copy of all incident reports, all video recording and 911 recordings, video recordings in any holding cell, all booking photos regarding named location and named individual or regarding other named individual and named location -2017-154).

Dear Ms. Rigney:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 657762.

After reviewing your arguments, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information must be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy.
