Re: Request for any complaints against or by named individual from 2009-2017 last known to live at named location. (NB #2017-211).

Dear Mr. Brown:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 664216.

After reviewing your arguments, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information must be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. Furthermore, in accordance with section 552.108(a)(1) you may withhold Exhibit C. However, you must release the basic information from Exhibit C pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.
