Re: Request for Case # 12-141032 regarding an assault on public servant incident which occurred 05/20/12 at named location to include the full police report, evidence, and photographs. (City Case # 17-1026-8495).

Dear Mr. Gabaldón:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 668171.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You inform us you will release some of the submitted information. You claim the remaining submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code. We have considered your arguments and the submitted information and have determined that in accordance with section 552.108(a)(2) you may withhold the remaining submitted information. However, you must release the basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.¹

¹We note the basic information includes the arrestee's social security number. Section 552.147(b) of the Government Code authorizes a governmental body to redact a living person's social security number from public release without the necessity of requesting a decision from this office under the Act. Gov't Code § 552.147(b).
