Dear Ms. Lentz:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 661859.

The Williamson County Sheriff's Office (the "sheriff's office") received a request for information pertaining to a specified incident. You claim some of the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.130 of the Government Code provides information relating to a motor vehicle operator's or driver's license or permit, a motor vehicle title or registration, or a personal identification document issued by an agency of Texas or another state or country is excepted from public release. Gov't Code § 552.130(a). Upon review, we find some of the submitted information, including some of the video recordings at issue, contains information subject to section 552.130. You state the sheriff's office does not have the technological capability to redact the motor vehicle record information from the video recordings. Accordingly, the sheriff's office must withhold the video recordings we have indicated, and the information you marked, under section 552.130 of the Government Code. *See* Open Records Decision No. 364 (1983). However, upon review, we find you have failed to demonstrate any of the remaining information is subject to section 552.130. Thus, the sheriff's office may not withhold any of the remaining information under section 552.130 of the Government Code. The remaining information must be released.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.
