Re: Request for any and all incident/offense reports or calls for service regarding two named addresses from 10/01/12 to the present and involving two named individuals.

Dear Mr. Grove

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 670948.

After reviewing your arguments, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information must be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. Furthermore, pursuant to section 552.108(a)(2) you may withhold report numbers 12-28957, 14-20536, and 16-34667. However, you must release the basic information from these three reports pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.
