Dear Mr. Gabaldón:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID#675956.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the submitted information must be withheld from the requestor. Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you must withhold case number 17-173022 pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 261.201 of the Family Code. Furthermore, we conclude you may withhold case number 17-173262 under section 552.108(a)(1). However, you must release the basic information from case number 17-173262 pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.
