Re: Request for all documents, including but not limited to complaints, police reports, incident reports regarding named individuals at named address from 01/01/02 to the present. (City Case # 17-1026-8668)

Dear Mr. Gabaldon:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 677980.

After reviewing your arguments, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information must be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy.
