Re: Request for documents relating to the arrests, indictments and cases involving named individuals from 2005 to 2007, and all statements made by named individuals pertaining to Flower Mound High School, hazing or assault from 2005 to 2007. (PIR 585-17 and 586-17)

Dear Ms. White:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 679106.

After reviewing your arguments, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information must be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. Furthermore, you must withhold report number 05028895 pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 261.201 of the Family Code.
