Dear Ms. Johnson:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 670467 (File No. 2017-01444).

The North Texas Tollway Authority (the "authority") received a request for information pertaining to a specified vehicle and a specified accident. You state the authority does not maintain some of the requested information.¹ You claim the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.101 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.101 of the Government Code excepts from disclosure "information considered to be confidential by law, either constitutional, statutory, or by judicial decision." Gov't Code § 552.101. Section 552.101 encompasses information other statutes make confidential. The authority is governed by the Texas Regional Tollway Authority Act, chapter 366 of the Transportation Code. Section 366.179 of the Transportation Code provides in relevant part the following:

- (a) For purposes of this section, a transponder is a device placed on or within a motor vehicle that is capable of transmitting or receiving information used to assess or collect tolls or provide toll exemptions. A transponder is

insufficiently funded if there is no money in the account for which the transponder was issued.

...

(d) Transponder account information, including contact and payment information and trip data, is confidential and not subject to disclosure under [the Act].

Transp. Code § 366.179(a), (d). The authority informs us, in connection with the operation of its toll projects, it issues transponders or "TollTags" to authority customers wishing to establish an account with the authority. The authority states the submitted information consists of TollTag customer account information that is compiled by the authority. Based on these representations, we agree the authority must withhold the submitted information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 366.179(d) of the Transportation Code.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.
