Re: Request for reports 2016-10206 and 2016-03850; any other reports at named location; any other reports regarding named individual; full case file of alleged domestic violence, etc.

Dear M:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 680451.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. First, we note a request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. Next, you claim report number 2017-00439 may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) and report number 2016-12855 may be withheld pursuant to section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and the information, we conclude you may withhold report number 2017-00439 under section 552.108(a)(1) and report number 2016-12855 under section 552.108(a)(2). However, you must release the basic information from report numbers 2017-00439 and 2016-12855 pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.
