Dear Mr. Kopp:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 678479 (COSA File No. W17177496).

The City of San Antonio (the "city") received a request for information pertaining to several offense reports. You state you have released some information to the requestor. You claim the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.101 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.


Initially, we note the submitted information was the subject of previous requests for rulings, as a result of which this office issued Open Records Letter Nos. 2017-14859 (2017) and 2017-15276 (2017). In Open Records Letter No. 2017-14859, we determined the city must withhold the information at issue under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with 58.007 of the Family Code. In Open Records Letter No. 2017-15276, we determined the city must withhold the information at issue under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. We understand the law, facts, or circumstances on which the prior rulings were based have not changed. Thus, the city may continue to rely on Open Records Letter Nos. 2017-14859 and 2017-15276 as previous determinations and withhold the information at issue in accordance with those rulings. *See* Open Records Decision No. 673 (2001) (so long as law, facts, and circumstances on which prior ruling was based have not changed, first type of previous determination exists where

requested information is precisely same information as was addressed in a prior attorney general ruling, ruling is addressed to same governmental body, and ruling concludes that information is or is not excepted from disclosure).

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
