Re: Request for any criminal complaints, waiver of counsel, offense reports, indictment, judgement/disposition or other information regarding named individuals. (ORR W064039)

Dear Mr. Austria:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 680961.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You state you have released some information to the requestor pursuant to section 411.087(a)(2) of the Government Code. *See Gov't Code § 411.087(a)(2)* (entity authorized to obtain person's criminal history record information from criminal justice agency in this state). You claim the remaining requested information must be withheld from the requestor. Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you must withhold the remaining information pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 58.007 of the Family Code.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup>We note the requestor is seeking information about an individual who is listed as an adult suspect, not a juvenile suspect or offender so as to implicate the access provided in section 58.007(e) of the Family Code. *See Fam. Code § 58.007(e)* (providing "[l]aw enforcement records and files concerning a child may be inspected or copied by ... a criminal justice agency as that term is defined by Section 411.082, Government Code[.]").
