Dear Ms. Anderson-Nelson:

This office issued Open Records Letter No. 2017-20066 (2017) on September 1, 2017. We have examined this ruling and determined we will correct the previously issued ruling. *See generally* Gov't Code § 552.011 (providing that Office of Attorney General may issue decision to maintain uniformity in application, operation, and interpretation of Public Information Act (the "Act")). Your request was assigned ID# 674011 (ORR W001740-061417).

Dallas Area Rapid Transit ("DART") received a request for information pertaining to a specified request for proposals.<sup>1</sup> You claim some of the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.104 of the Government Code. You also state you notified Ask in Tag LLC; Electronic Data Magnetics, Inc.; InComm Holdings, Inc. ("InComm"); PayNearMe MT, Inc. ("PayNearMe"); and Ready Credit Corporation ("Ready") of the request for information and of their right to submit arguments to this office as to why the submitted information should not be released. *See id.* § 552.305(d); *see also* Open Records Decision No. 542 (1990) (statutory predecessor to section 552.305 permits governmental body to rely on interested third party to raise and explain applicability of exception in the Act in certain circumstances). We have received comments from InComm and PayNearMe. We have considered the submitted arguments and reviewed the submitted information.

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<sup>1</sup>You state DART sought and received clarification of the information requested. *See* Gov't Code § 552.222 (providing if request for information is unclear, governmental body may ask requestor to clarify request); *see also* *City of Dallas v. Abbott*, 304 S.W.3d 380, 387 (Tex. 2010) (holding that when a governmental entity, acting in good faith, requests clarification or narrowing of an unclear or overbroad request for information, the ten-day period to request an attorney general ruling is measured from the date the request is clarified or narrowed).

We note the information at issue was the subject of a previous request for information, as a result of which this office issued Open Records Letter No. 2017-11518B (2017). We have no indication the law, facts, or circumstances on which the prior ruling was based have changed. Thus, DART must continue to rely on Open Records Letter No. 2017-1151B as a previous determination and withhold or release the information at issue in accordance with that ruling. *See* Open Records Decision No. 673 (2001) (so long as law, facts, and circumstances on which prior ruling was based have not changed, first type of previous determination exists where requested information is precisely same information as was addressed in a prior attorney general ruling, ruling is addressed to same governmental body, and ruling concludes that information is or is not excepted from disclosure). As we are able to make this determination, we need not address the submitted arguments.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
