Re: Request for any and all offense reports, 911 calls, incidents reports, calls for services for named locaiton, specifically involving named individual prior to 08/06/17; any and all reports, calls for services, 911 calls, traffic stops involving named individual prior to same date.

Dear Mr. Fultz:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 683273.

After reviewing your arguments, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information must be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. Furthermore, you must withhold Exhibits B and D pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 261.201 of the Family Code.
