Dear Mr. Tijerina:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 683091.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You have released the 2009 report and claim the submitted information must be withheld from the requestor. Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you must withhold report numbers 2017-00004499, 2017-00010245, and 2017-00005848 pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 58.008(b) of the Family Code. Furthermore, you may withhold the information marked as "552.108" in the 2015 report under section 552.108(a)(2) and must withhold the marked dates of birth in the 2015 report pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. *Paxton v. City of Dallas*, No. 03-13-00546-CV, 2015 WL 3394061, at *3 (Tex. App.—Austin May 22, 2015, pet. denied) (mem. op.).
