Dear Mr. Rodriguez:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 679008 (COSA File No. W177927-072717).

The City of San Antonio (the "city") received a request for all bids and proposals submitted to the city regarding media services pertaining to a specified event. You claim the requested information is the subject of a previous determination. We have considered your argument.

You state the requested information was the subject of a previous request for information, in response to which this office issued Open Records Letter No. 2017-17413 (2017). In that ruling, we determined (1) the city may withhold the information we marked under section 552.107 of the Government Code, and (2) must release the remaining information. We have no indication the law, facts, and circumstances on which the prior ruling was based have changed. Accordingly, we conclude the city may continue to rely on Open Records Letter No. 2017-17413 as a previous determination and withhold or release the identical information in accordance with that ruling. *See* Open Records Decision No. 673 (2001) (so long as law, facts, and circumstances on which prior ruling was based have not changed, first type of previous determination exists where requested information is precisely same information as was addressed in prior attorney general ruling, ruling is addressed to same governmental body, and ruling concludes information is or is not excepted from disclosure).

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
