Dear Ms. Pulsney:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 689291 (JGal4).


The Corpus Christi Police Department (the "department") received a request for information pertaining to the requestor and another named individual for August of 2016. The department claims the requested information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.101 of the Government Code. We have considered the claimed exception and reviewed the submitted information.

The submitted information was the subject of a previous request for information, in response to which this office issued Open Records Letter No. 2016-24103 (2016). In Open Records Letter No. 2016-24103, we determined the department must withhold the submitted information in its entirety under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 261.201(a) of the Family Code. We have no indication the law, facts, or circumstances on which the prior ruling was based have changed. Accordingly, the department must rely on Open Records Letter No. 2016-24103 as a previous determination and withhold the submitted information in accordance with that ruling.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
