The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 686141.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the submitted video recordings must be withheld from the requestor in their entireties pursuant to section 552.130 of the Government Code because you lack the technological capability to redact from the recordings the motor vehicle record information not pertaining to the individual for whom requestor is acting as the authorized representative. Thus, we agree you must withhold the submitted video recordings pursuant to section 552.130 of the Government Code.
