Re: Request for records involving a named individual

Dear Mr. Schleier:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 694703.

After reviewing your arguments, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information must be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. Next, you must withhold report number 1701-1172 pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 58.008(b) of the Family Code. Finally, you may withhold report numbers 1703-0706 and 1703-1029 under section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code, but must release the basic information from these reports pursuant to section 552.108(c).
