Dear Ms. Solis:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 693901.

After reviewing your arguments, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You explain you have no information responsive to request item one and claim the information responsive to request item two must be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. Furthermore, you may withhold Exhibit B under section 552.108(a)(1) and Exhibit C under section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code. However, you must release the basic information from the reports in Exhibits B and C that are otherwise excepted from disclosure by section 552.108 pursuant to section 552.108(c).
