Dear Ms. Cost:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 687234 (PIR# 17-6924).

The Texas Department of Public Safety (the "department") received two requests for specified video recordings pertaining to a specified investigation. You state you will release some information. Although you take no position as to whether the submitted information is excepted under the Act, you state release of this information may implicate the interests of the Prairie View A&M University Police Department (the "police department"). Accordingly, you have notified the police department of the request pursuant to section 552.304 of the Government Code. *See* Gov't Code § 552.304 (interested party may submit comments stating why information should or should not be released). We have reviewed the submitted information. As of the date of this letter, we have not received any comments from the police department explaining why any portion of the information should not be released to the requestor. As no exceptions to disclosure have been raised, the department must release the submitted information.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
