Dear Mr. Gomez:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 694192.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. First, you explain you have no information responsive to the request as to one investigation, and you are relying on Open Records Letter No. 2017-11101 (2017) for two other investigations. *See* Open Records Decision No. 673 (2001) (so long as law, facts, and circumstances on which prior ruling was based have not changed, first type of previous determination exists where requested information is precisely same information as was addressed in prior attorney general ruling, ruling is addressed to same governmental body, and ruling concludes that information is or is not excepted from disclosure). You claim Exhibits A and B may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) and Exhibit C may be withheld pursuant to section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and the information, we conclude you may withhold Exhibits A and B under section 552.108(a)(1) and Exhibit C under section 552.108(a)(2).
