Re: Request for all information regarding named individual including any crash/accident reports, investigation reports, police/incident reports, arrest reports, photos, video and audio recordings, 911 calls and recordings, call sheets, witness statements, station interviews, dash cam videos, and officer worn camera videos; information regarding disturbances or calls for assistance involving named individual; information regarding any arrest, detention, jailing, and investigation of named individual;

Dear Mr. Ray:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 696226.

After reviewing your arguments, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the requested information must be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy.
