
You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 746309.

The Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center at El Paso (the "center") received a request for specified communications and information pertaining to a specified grant application. You state the center has released some of the requested information. Although you take no position as to whether the submitted information is excepted under the Act, you state release of this information may implicate the interests of a named individual. *See* Gov't Code § 552.304 (interested party may submit comments stating why information should or should not be released). We have reviewed the submitted information. As of the date of this letter, we have not received any comments from the named individual explaining why any of the submitted information should not be released. Accordingly, the submitted information must be released.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
