The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 753562.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim report number 18013795 must be withheld from the requestor. Upon review of your arguments and report number 18013795, we conclude you must withhold report number 18013795 pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 58.008(b) of the Family Code.¹ You state you have released basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code from report number 15011794 and claim report number 15011794 may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and report number 15011794, we conclude you may withhold report number 15011794 under section 552.108(a)(1).
