Dear Ms. Dada-Olley:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 755069 (ORR# AS180007).

The City of Plano (the "city") received a request for information pertaining to a specified incident and a particular animal. The city claims some of the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.101 of the Government Code. We have considered the claimed exception and reviewed the submitted information.


We note the requested information that the city seeks to withhold was the subject of a previous request for information, in response to which this office issued Open Records Letter No. 2019-00234 (2019). In Open Records Letter No. 2019-00234, we determined the city must withhold some information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 826.0211 (a) of the Health and Safety Code, but must release the remaining information. We have no indication the law, facts, or circumstances on which the prior ruling was based have changed. Accordingly, the city must rely on Open Records Letter No. 2019-00234 as a previous determination and withhold or release the identical information in accordance with that ruling.¹

¹As our ruling is dispositive, we do not address the arguments of the city to withhold this information.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.
