You state you have released basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code and claim the submitted information. You claim Exhibit B may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) and Exhibit C may be withheld pursuant to section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and the information, we conclude you may withhold Exhibit B under section 552.108(a)(1) and Exhibit C under section 552.108(a)(2).
