The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 767557 (ORR# W028260).

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim incident report number 19-001761 may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) and the remaining may be withheld pursuant to section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and the information, we conclude you may withhold incident report number 19-001761 under section 552.108(a)(1) and the remaining under section 552.108(a)(2). However, you must release the basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.¹
