Dear Ms. Bastian:

This office issued Open Records Letter No. 2019-34081 on December 4, 2019 pertaining to a request for five categories of information pertaining to a specified murder investigation. However, in a letter dated January 22, 2020, you withdrew your request on behalf of the Harlingen Police Department for an open records decision regarding this request because the requestor had voluntarily withdrawn her request prior to the issuance of the ruling from our office. Based on your representations, we will correct the previously issued ruling. Consequently, this serves as the correct decision and is a substitute for the decision issued on December 4, 2019. *See generally* Gov't Code § 552.011 (providing that Office of Attorney General may issue decision to maintain uniformity in application, operation, and interpretation of the Public Information Act).

As you state, and provide documentation showing, the requestor withdrew her request for information voluntarily, this office will consider this matter closed.
