The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 802316.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. Initially, we note you have not submitted information responsive to the request for meeting minutes and agendas pertaining to the specified meeting. To the extent any additional responsive information responsive existed on the date you received the request, we assume you have released it. If you have not released any such information, you must do so at this time. *See* Gov't Code §§ 552.301(a), .302; *see also* Open Records Decision No. 664 (2000) (if governmental body concludes no exceptions apply to requested information, it must release information as soon as possible). You claim the submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.107 of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you may withhold the submitted information under section 552.107.
