The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 805125.

After reviewing your arguments, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. Initially, we note the information we marked is not responsive because it does not pertain to the individual named in the requests. This ruling does not address the public availability of any information that is not responsive to the requests and you are not required to release such information in response to these requests. You claim the requested information must be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold the requested information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy.
