Dear Ms. Carpenter:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 811657 (Ref. Nos. 2020-234 & 2020-238).

The Round Rock Independent School District (the "district") received two requests for information pertaining to specified grievances.¹ Additionally, you state the second requestor sought the video recording pertaining to a specified proceeding. You state the district will release the video recording to the second requestor upon payment of costs. You claim the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under sections 552.101 and 552.103 of the Government Code.² We have considered the exceptions you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

We note the submitted information was the subject of previous requests for information, in response to which this office issued Open Records Letter No. 2020-02782 (2020). In that ruling, we determined, in pertinent part, with the exception of the information subject to section 552.022(a)(1) of the Government Code, which must generally be released, the district may withhold the information at issue under section 552.103 of the Government Code. Further, we determined, in releasing the information subject to section 552.022(a)(1) of the Government Code, to the extent the individuals whose information is at issue timely


² Although you also raise section 552.101 in conjunction with common-law privacy, constitutional privacy, and physical safety for the submitted information, you provide no arguments explaining how these doctrines are applicable to the information at issue. Therefore, we assume you no longer assert these doctrines. *See* Gov't Code §§ 552.301, .302.

requested confidentiality under section 552.024 of the Government Code, the district must withhold certain information under section 552.117(a)(1) of the Government Code; however, the cellular telephone numbers at issue may be withheld only if a governmental body does not pay for the cellular telephone service. We have no indication the law, facts, and circumstances on which the prior ruling was based have changed. Accordingly, the district may continue to rely on Open Records Letter No. 2020-02782 as a previous determination and withhold or release the submitted information in accordance with that ruling.³ See Open Records Decision No. 673 (2001) (so long as law, facts, and circumstances on which prior ruling was based have not changed, first type of previous determination exists where requested information is precisely same information as was addressed in prior attorney general ruling, ruling is addressed to same governmental body, and ruling concludes that information is or is not excepted from disclosure).

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
