Dear Mr. Kopp:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 813706 (COSA File No. W294612).

The City of San Antonio (the "city") received a request for a specified police report. You claim some of the submitted information is not responsive to the request for information. We have considered the submitted argument and reviewed the submitted information.

You assert some of the submitted information that consists of "automatic systems warnings" is not responsive to the request for information. However, this information is located within the police report that was specifically requested. Thus, we find this information is responsive to the request for information. Therefore, the city must release this information, unless it is excepted from release under the Act. As no exceptions to disclosure are raised, the city must release the submitted information.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.
