Dear Mr. Tyler:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 817337 (ORR# W095614).

After reviewing your arguments, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You state you have released some requested information pursuant to section 411.087(a)(2) of the Government Code. *See* Gov't Code § 411.087(a)(2) (entity authorized to obtain person's criminal history record information from criminal justice agency in this state). You claim the remaining requested information must be withheld from the requestor. A request to compile an individual's criminal history implicates this person's privacy. We have concluded such a compilation is highly embarrassing information and is generally not of legitimate concern to the public. Therefore, to the extent you maintain any remaining law enforcement records depicting the named individual as a suspect, arrestee, or criminal defendant, you must withhold any such remaining information under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy.
