Dear Ms. Harden:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 816905 (PIR# R003161).

The Office of the Attorney General (the "OAG") received a request information pertaining to a specified type of contract. Although the OAG takes no position on the submitted information, the OAG informs us release of this information may implicate the interests of Kendall County, McMullen County, Refugio County, Tom Green County, and Trinity County. Accordingly, the OAG states it notified these third parties of the request for information and of their rights to submit arguments to this office as to why the information at issue should not be released. *See* Gov't Code § 552.304 (interested party may submit written comments regarding availability of requested information). We have reviewed the submitted information.

As of the date of this letter, we have not received any comments from any of the third parties explaining why any portion of the submitted information should not be released to the requestor. As no exceptions to disclosure have been raised, the submitted information must be released.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor.
