Dear Mr. Schleier:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 825110.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You state you have released information to the requestor, including any court-filed documents pursuant to section 552.022(a)(17) of the Government Code, basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code, and a CR-3 accident report pursuant to section 550.065(c) of the Transportation Code. You claim the remaining information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you may withhold the submitted information under section 552.108(a)(2).¹
