Dear Ms. Hojem:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 839261 (MTA No. 2020-0353).

This office issued Open Records Letter No. 2020-14541 (2020) on May 26, 2020. We received your correspondence of June 1, 2020, in which we understand you to withdraw your request for an open records decision on behalf of the Metro Transit Authority of Harris County (the "authority"), regarding a request for information pertaining to a specified incident involving a named individual. We have examined this correspondence and determined we will substitute this letter for Open Records Letter No. 2020-14541. *See generally* Gov't Code § 552.011 (providing that Office of Attorney General may issue decision to maintain uniformity in application, operation, and interpretation of Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code). Your request was assigned ID# 839261.

We understand you wish to withdraw your request for an open records decision because, after requesting a ruling pursuant to section 552.301(b) of the Government Code, the authority closed its offices or limited operations to a skeleton crew. Therefore, the authority is unable to provide the information required by section 552.301(e) of the Government Code. Based on these representations, this office will consider this matter closed.
