Dear Ms. Camp-Lee:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 844860.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. In this instance, the requestor does not give the requisite information under section 1701.661(a) of the Occupations Code. As the requestor did not properly request the body worn camera recording(s) at issue pursuant to chapter 1701, our ruling does not reach this information and it need not be released. You claim the remaining information must be withheld from the requestor. You claim the remaining information must be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code. The requestor in this case knows the identity of the victim in the report at issue. To protect the privacy of the individual to whom the information at issue relates, you must withhold the remaining information in its entirety under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy.
