Dear Mr. Martinez:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 843100 (ORR# 20-0407).

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the information marked under section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to that section. Upon review of your arguments and the information, we conclude you may withhold the information marked under section 552.108(a)(2). You must withhold the marked date of birth pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. *Paxton v. City of Dallas*, No. 03-13-00546-CV, 2015 WL 3394061, at *3 (Tex. App.—Austin May 22, 2015, pet. denied) (mem. op.). You must release the remaining information.¹
