Re: Request for all specified information regarding arrest of named individual on 07/03/20 (R001262)

Dear Mr. Carroll:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 846478 (COO Req. No. R001262-071420).

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue.<sup>1</sup> Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. Upon review, we find you must release the DIC-24 Statutory Warning and the DIC-25 Notice of Suspension. In releasing the DIC-24 and DIC-25 forms, you must withhold the driver license information under section 552.130 of the Government Code and the date of birth pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. *Paxton v. City of Dallas*, No. 03-13-00546-CV, 2015 WL 3394061, at \*3 (Tex. App.—Austin May 22, 2015, pet. denied) (mem. op.). Upon review of your arguments and the remaining information, we conclude you may withhold the remaining information under

<sup>1</sup> We note the City of Odessa (the “city”) indicates it previously received a request for the same information from this requestor. In response to the previous request, the city informs us it released basic information to the requestor within five business days and withheld certain information under section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code, pursuant to the previous determination this office issued to the city in Open Records Letter No. 2020-12335 (2020). Subsequently, the requestor made a second request for the same information on July 15, 2020.

section 552.108(a)(1).<sup>2</sup> However, as you acknowledge, you must release the basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.
